1. Dean Birdsall from Litchfield High School attended. He will be rallying the students to participate in the Earth day clean up.
2. John Wages, head of Earth Day, attended. He will be in charge of the activities at White Memorial on April 21. Residents can pick up the plastic bags and gloves there, or arrange to get them from public works earlier. At noon, there will be hotdogs provided by the Rotary.
